Dear Mr. Logan,

On February 4, 2015, we received your public records request asking for the following:

Records dating from Jan. 3, 2011 until Feb. 2, 2015 relating to the analysis of net benefit to the state of spending on highway expansion projects that are included in your 2016-2017 budget request - as presented to the office of the Governor or Secretary of Transportation. . . . In the event there is not an analysis of cost available, I would like to receive a clear statement to that effect with an explanation of why the state does not perform that level of due diligence for highway projects - as well as the records (dating from the last major revision of admin code trans-210 to present) which document this policy.

We have located records related to the topic of your request. A copy of these records is attached in PDF format. Note that we are not able to search records held by state agencies. If you are looking for records held by other offices, such as the Department of Transportation, you are welcome to reach out to those agencies directly.
